

Purdue University's Technical Assistance Program (TAP) continues to engage business, industry, healthcare, and government in Indiana and beyond.



For more than 900 employers in nearly every Indiana county, our network of 172 engaged Purdue faculty, students, and staff addresses tough challenges and supports new business opportunities.

Our Manufacturing Extension Partnership center and other initiatives toward competitiveness, technology adoption, and workforce development created jobs, increased sales, and reduced costs for Indiana companies this year. Meanwhile, our Purdue Healthcare Advisors brought millions of dollars to Indiana by partnering with hospitals and healthcare organizations to facilitate governmental compliance with Electronic Health Records systems.
